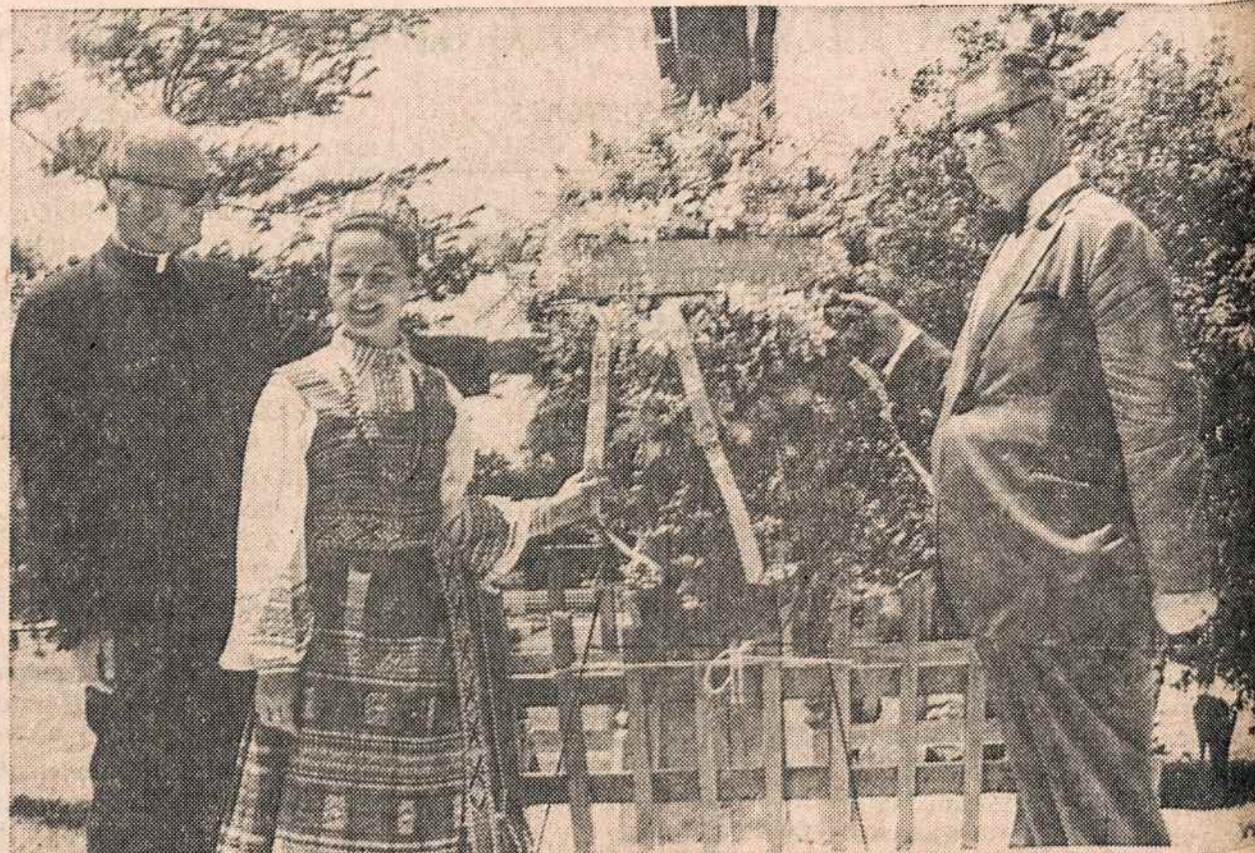

Proclamation

Greeting:

WHEREAS, the Baltic nations of Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia proclaimed their independence on February 16, November 18 and February 24, 1918, respectively, following more than 120 years of oppression by Czarist Russia, and

WHEREAS, the three Baltic peoples who lived on the shores of the Baltic sea for over 4,000 years gained their liberty from the Germans and Russians following World War I and remained free until World War II, when the U.S.S.R. occupied their countries on June 15-17, 1940, and

WHEREAS, these religious, freedom-loving Baltic peoples resisted the occupation of their homelands, subversion of their institutions by the Communists, their obliteration as distinct nations and people, with Communist Russia suppressing resistance by exterminations of Lithuanians, Latvians and Estonians, and even then, failing to subjugate the spirit of these people, the ruthless conquerors departed and banished on June 15, 1941 about 700,000 of these nationals to the slave-labor camps of Siberia;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIDNEY LEVISS, President of the Borough of Queens, the City of New York, proclaim June 15, 1969

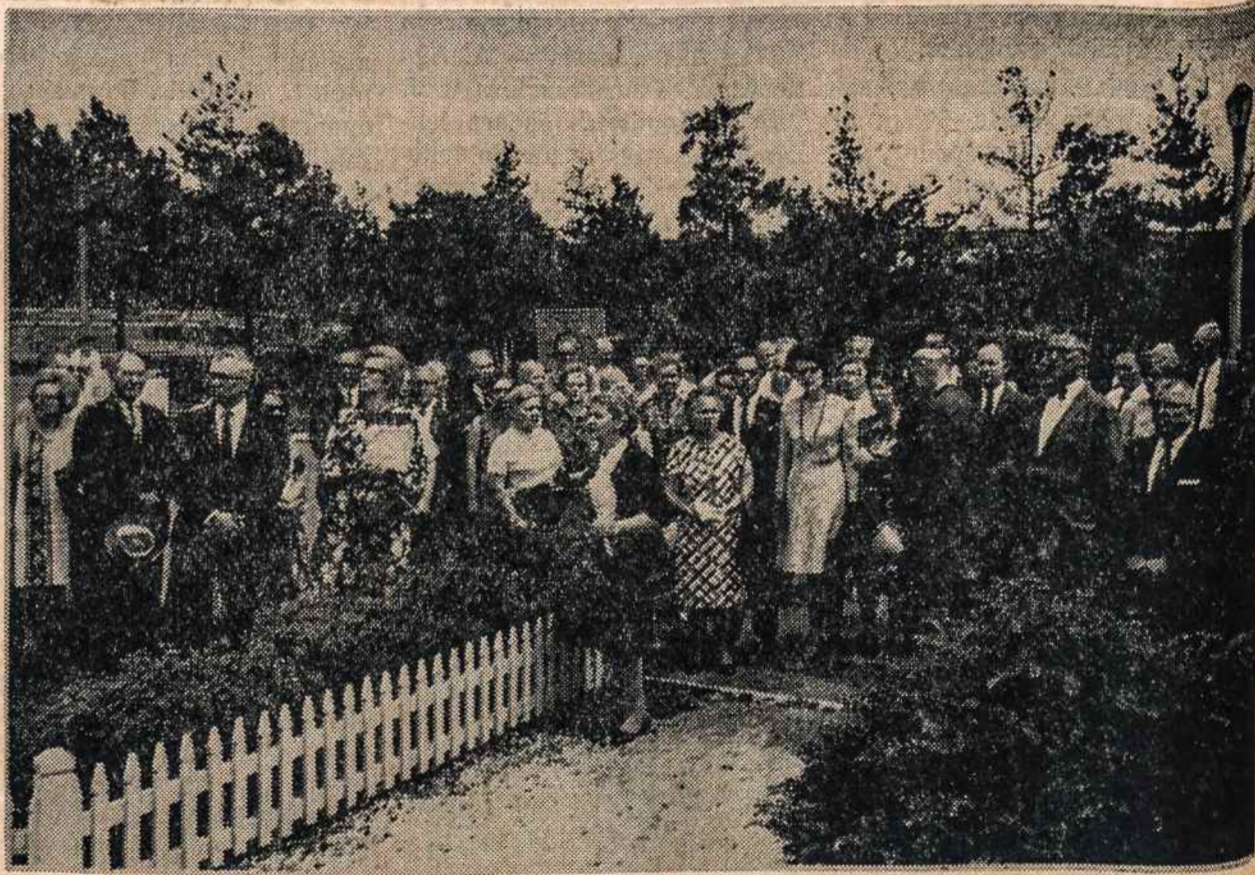
CONGREGATION DAY OF THE MASS DEPORTATION TO SIBERIA OF LITHUANIANS, LATVIANS AND ESTONIANS

in Queens and urge all our residents to recall the hardships suffered by these people under Communist oppression.

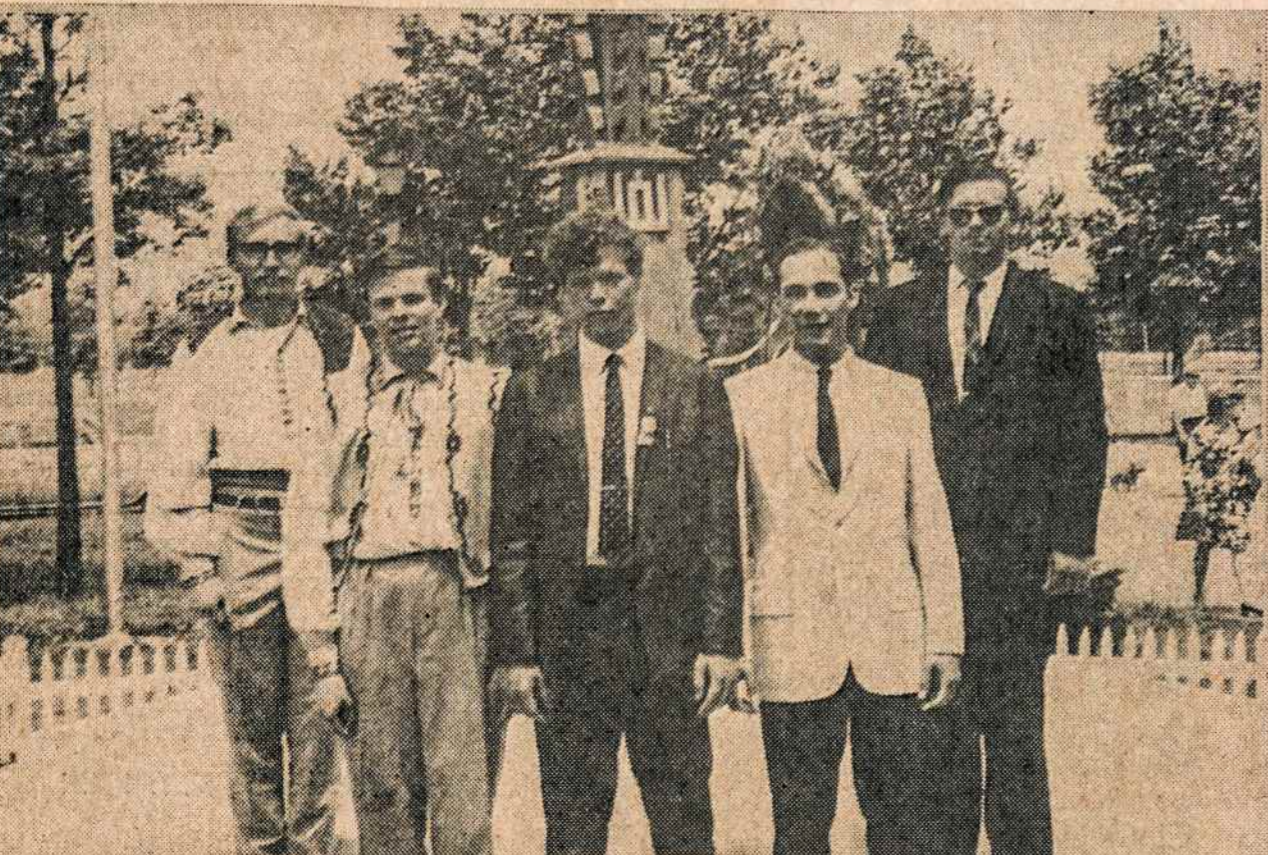
Done at Borough Hall, New Gardens, in the City of New York, on this third day of June, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.
