Pasirašę Piliečių Komiteto nariai tvirtai tiki, kad Jūs turėtumėte teisę balsuoti dėl šio visų svarbiausio klausimo. Mes raginame Jus sujungti savo jėgas su mūsų

jėgomis, ir suvienytomis pastangomis praveisti ribotų banko skyrių įsteigimo pasiūlymą artimiausiuose visuotiniuose rinkimuose.

Tekstą ir faktiškąją H. B. 108 analizę ir šį klausimą liečiančią istorinę medžiagą galite gauti paprašę.

Panaudokite parankų žemiau pridėtų kuponą. Kai pakankamai gerai susipažinsite su šia informacija, susizinkite su savo legislatoriais Springfielde iki 1959 metų gegužės mėn. 20 d.
