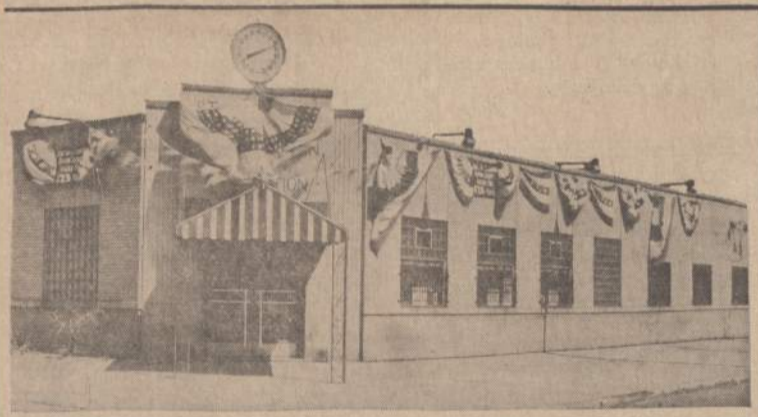
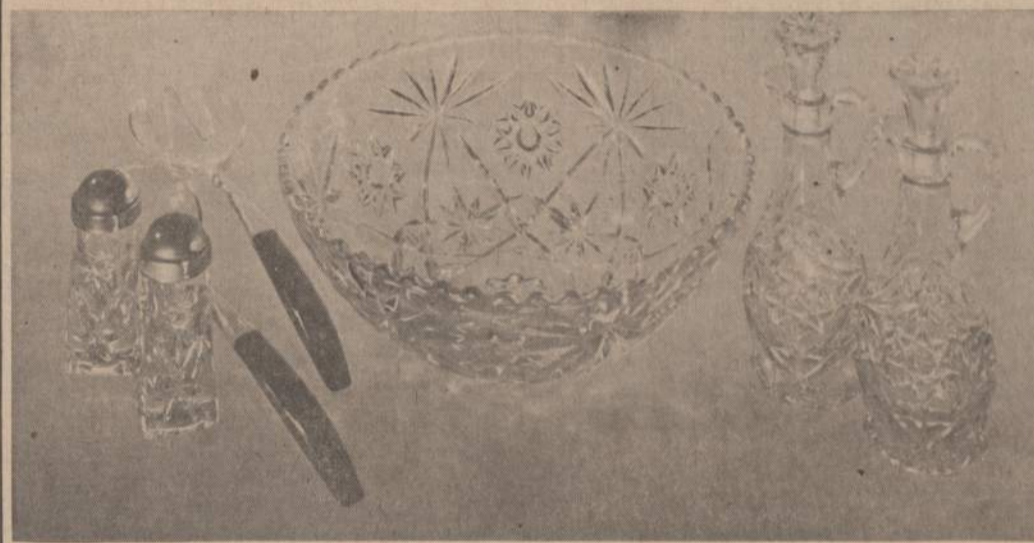

St. Anthony Savings & Loan Association was incorporated in 1922 by civic minded men from the Grant Works area of Cicero. For the first 15 years, all business was transacted only on Monday evenings in the classrooms of St. Anthony's Parochial School. In 1938, the association received insurance of savings accounts and approved membership in the Federal Home Loan Bank, and a full time office was opened in the school building.

Joseph F. Gribauskas, then a recent graduate of St. Mary's College in Winona, Minnesota, took over the duties of Managing Officer in 1939 on the insistence of the Board of Directors. Great strides were made in public relations and the numbers of savers and borrowers were on the increase. In order to accommodate all, ground was broken on the 25th Anniversary (1947) for a new office building at the present location. On the 30th Anniversary (1952), the number of teller windows were doubled, so that better and faster service could be given to the mounting number of savers. On the 35th Anniversary (1957), the whole interior of the office building was remodeled and the most modern bookkeeping system and office machinery were installed. On the 40th Anniversary (1962), a second story to the office building was added and land was purchased to the north of the building for a parking lot to accommodate "drive-in" customers. In 1967, in commemoration of the 45th Anniversary, the exterior of the building was illuminated in colored lights as a symbol of continued progress.

St. Anthony's has extended a helping hand to over 25,000 savers and borrowers to the populous of Chicago and the suburbs with prejudice to none.
